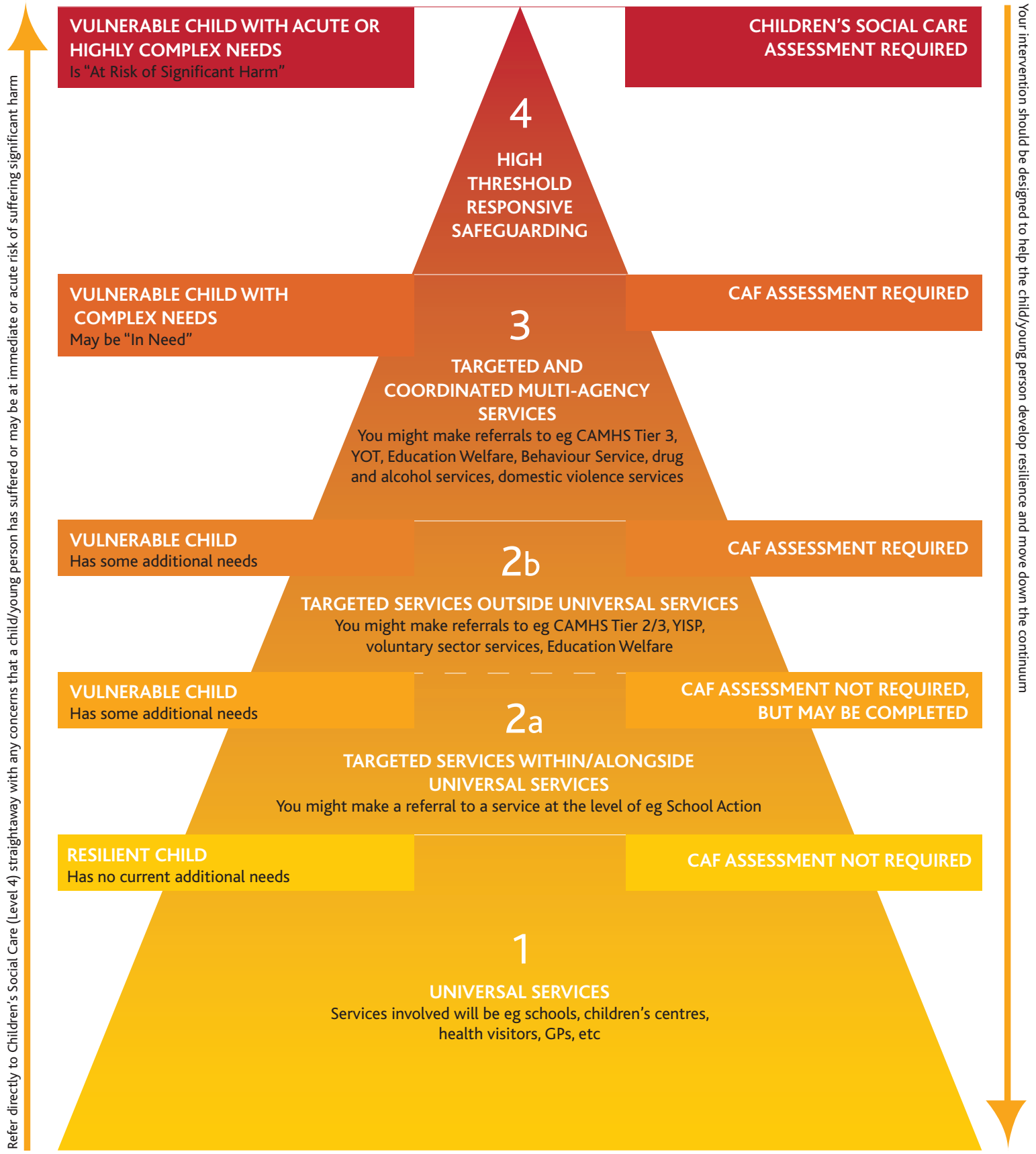




What do I do if I am concerned that a child or young person has additional needs?

The expectation is that most children and young people's additional needs will be identified at an early stage by workers in Universal Services; however, you must always be prepared to assess the complexity of a child or young person's needs and intervene at the appropriate level.

Bromley Continuum of Need and Intervention



CAF stands for 'Common Assessment Framework'.
To be used in conjunction with BSCB document "Bromley Continuum of Need and Intervention: Safeguarding Threshold Guidance".
CAF assessment not normally required if another multi-agency Bromley specialist referral has been or will be made (eg. Early Support, Sensory Support for children with disabilities).
